



HOW TO CREATE

YOUR 2020 TRUMP CARDS DECK



You will need:

- •1x printer
- •1 x scissors (per person) safety scissors are recommended for kids



Optional:

- 3 x empty cereal boxes
- •1x glue stick (per person)
- 36 x plastic card sleeves

This game is a perfect arts & crafts activity for kids on summer holiday, as part of a club or even just at home with friends and family! Grab the above materials and prepare to start cutting and sticking!

Each one of the pages inluded in this pack has 6 cards on it, each depicting a different country and featuring some key Olympic Games stats. Simply cut around the dotted line on each card to build your deck!

Once you've cut out all 36 cards, you can either start playing immediately by following the rule book attached to the bottom of this page, or optionally you can print out our Olympics 2020 card backs and stick them to the back of your cards to make it feel more authentic (and prevent any cheating)! If you want to make these cards more durable and play over and over again, why not stick the sheets of cards to an old cereal box before you cut it? Then you can simply stick the card backs on to have some official looking Olympics trump cards!

HOW TO PLAY

OLYMPICS 2020 TRUMP CARDS

Players: 2-6

Game length: 10 - 20

CUT ME OUT

How to play:

- 1. Shuffle the deck of cards and deal them out evenly between all players. Make sure each player can only see the trump card in their hand.
- 2. Choose who goes first we recommend the youngest player starts!
- 3. The first player must choose one statistic on their trump card to read out (e.g. Gold models)
- 4. Compare the number next to that stat with the same stat on everyone else's trump card. The highest number or earliest date wins that round.
- 5. The winner must collect everyone else's top cards and add them to the back of their hand. If a player loses all their cards, they are out of the game.
- 6. Move to the player on the left of the current player and repeat steps 3-6.


How to win

The game is over when one player has the entire deck in their hand at the end of a round, this player is the winner!

In the event of a draw

If two or more cards have the same number, that round is a draw and the cards are added to a pile in the middle. The player who wins the next round collects those cards too.

Those are just the basic rules, however you can play the game however you like. Why not keep a tally of how many times you win against your friends and family? You could even mix it up and start challenging each other using Olympics trivia, or play a game of higher or lower with the whole deck.



How to play Olympics 2020 trump cards

Players: 2-6

Game length: 10 - 20 minutes

How to play:

- 1. Shuffle the deck and deal them out evenly
- 2. Choose who goes first.
- 3. Choose one statistic on their trump card to read out (e.g. Gold medals).
- 4. Compare the number next to that stat with the same stat on everyone else's trump card. The highest number or earliest date wins that round. 5. The winner must collect everyone else's trump
- 5. The winner must collect everyone else's trump cards and add them to the back of their hand. If a player loses all their cards, they are out of the game

How to win:

Go round in a clockwise circle repeating steps 3-5. The game is over when one player has the entire deck in their hand at the end of a round, this player is the winner!

In the event of a draw

If two or more cards have the same number, that round is a draw and the cards are added to a pile in the middle. The player who wins the next round collects those cards too.
